## Secret of success: logistics- at Hidden Champions the product and the service are right

Customers' clear requirements with regard to the desired service are essential. Johannes Riegl, Managing Director at Riegl Laser Management Systems, fully agreed from the customer's point of view.

Mag. Gerald Steger, Managing Director at café+co International, and Dkfm. Hans Staud, Managing Director at the Viennese jam manufacturer Staud's, pointed out the required flexibility as one of the core requirements for logistics processes.

After the panel discussion and presentation of the certificates to the newly qualified leading companies, the discussions about special topics regarding logistics and Hidden Champions continued over wine and wonderful delicacies. Mag. Monica Rintersbacher was delighted about the successful evening and the quality of the exchange of information between representatives of leading Austrian companies.
